We will have full travel teams, limited travel teams, and half year travel teams for the 2024-2025 season. The clinics and tryouts will be used to evaluate each athlete's skill level.

This will help us determine which team will be the best fit for your athlete.

If you prefer to be on a limited travel team, please make sure to put that on your tryout form.

FORMING SUCCESSFUL TEAMS

There are a lot of factors that are involved when forming successful teams. Some factors include age, tumbling skills, stunting ability, and experience. A mix of specific tumbling, jumping, stunting, dancing skills are needed in each routine to score well.

Coaches will make teams and choose levels based on what it takes to be successful as a team and have high scoring routines. The ideal situation is every athlete on the team is involved in every section of the routine and can be a productive member of the team. Every athlete is on the team for a reason – please trust the process.

We work extremely hard and push every athlete to reach their highest individual potential, while also teaching them the importance of teamwork. Being off task during tryouts, having a negative attitude or showing disrespect to other athletes or staff members may result in an athlete not being placed on a team at World Class Athletics PCB.

All teams & levels are important. We must place athletes on a level where they are doing skills with confidence AND excellent technique. This will help all teams be competitive for their division throughout the season while keeping the stress level down for all athletes.

COMMITMENT LEVELS

For the 2024 -2025 season we are offering two time/travel commitment levels. You decide what commitment level works best for your family - limited travel, or full travel! This does not guarantee an elite spot for your athlete.

LIMITED TRAVEL TEAMS

Limited travel teams will attend 1 day competitions in the Bay County area plus 2-3 out of town competitions.

1 team practice per week

Financial details for limited travel teams are listed on page 4 of this packet.

Limited travel teams will be in the Novice and Prep divisions at competitons

FULL TRAVEL TEAMS

Full travel teams will attend several out of town competitions each season.

2 team practices per week.

Financial details for full travel teams are listed on page 6 of this packet.

Full travel teams will be in the Elite divisions at competitons.

You will list which commitment level works for your family when filling out your online registration for tryouts. This will not guarantee an elite spot for your athlete. Coaches will form teams with-in these categories at the appropriate age/skill level.



LIMITED TRAVEL TEAMS

NOVICE AND PREP DIVISION ATHLETES

Limited travel teams will attend 1 day competitions in and around the Bay County area plus 2-3 out of town competitions. The official competition schedule will be released in the summer months.

Athletes on limited travel teams will have team practice once per week. Additional classes are available at a discounted rate of \$50/ per month /per athlete.

The table below is an estimate of costs for the 2024 - 2025 limited travel teams.

These prices are based on previous seasons and may change slightly.

AUTOMATIC PAYMENT POLICY

Monthly tuition will be billed to your World Class account on the 25th of each month for all athletes. The card on file will be set up to automatically pay the tuition fee on the 25th of each month starting May 25, 2024. If you would like to use a different payment method, tuition fees must be paid before the 25th. World Class Athletics PCB accepts cash, debit, checks, and all major credit cards. You may also pay online through the parent portal at www.worldclassathleticsllc.com.

WORLD CLASS ATHLETICS FINANCIAL STABILITY CLAUSE

If for any reason your account gets behind, we have built in some extra time to get these amounts paid. In an effort to keep account balances at a manageable level, World Class Athletics PCB has implemented a Financial Stability Clause. For the 2024-2025 season, balances must be below a certain dollar amount in order for each cheerleader to continue to participate in practice and/or perform at competition. If you carry a balance on the account, it is mandatory that you participate in any fundraising opportunities throughout the season.

FULL TRAVEL TEAMS

ELITE DIVISION ATHLETES

World Class Athletics PCB full travel teams attend several out of town and local events.

The official competition schedule for our full travel teams will be released during the summer months to give our families time to plan accordingly for the season ahead. Athletes will travel and stay in hotels with their parents.

Please keep in mind by selecting a full year travel team your athlete will be required to travel several times throughout the season and may miss a few days of school in the process. We recommend athletes keep up with assignments, homework, and attendance throughout the school year so that these missed travel days do not negatively impact your athletes overall academics.

Athletes on full travel teams will have team practice twice per week.

Additional classes are available at a discounted rate of \$50/ per month /per athlete.

AUTOMATIC PAYMENT POLICY

Monthly tuition will be billed to your World Class account on the 25th of each month for all athletes. The card on file will be set up to automatically pay the tuition fee on the 25th of each month starting May 25, 2024. If you would like to use a different payment method, tuition fees must be paid before the 25th. World Class Athletics PCB accepts cash, debit, checks, and all major credit cards. WORLD CLASS ATHLETICS FINANCIAL STABILITY CLAUSE

ANY PROBLEMS OR CONFLICTS SHOULD BE BROUGHT TO THE ATTENTION OF THE WORLD CLASS MANAGEMENT IMMEDIATELY AND NOT TO OTHER PARENTS AND/OR ATHLETES. NO DRAMA!

World Class Athletics PCB maintains the right to refuse services at any time. World Class Athletics PCB may add, subtract or change any rule at any time.

Good sportsmanship and good manners are mandatory for athletes and family members at all scheduled events.

Please remember you are representing the entire WCA program.

NO GOSSIP about any other child, parent or team(s) will be tolerated (school or all star). NO GOSSIP about WCA coaches, owners, and staff. If this policy is violated, you will be asked to leave World Class Athletics PCB immediately.

Please remember that World Class is responsible for many children. Ensure your child's safety by dropping off/picking up ON TIME. Coaches are booked throughout the day and require the gym space for other teams, classes, and private lessons.

You must arrive at all WCA scheduled events ON TIME. Punctuality is a must. Tardiness could result in indirect consequences for your child.

It is your responsibility to wear the correct practice wear, hair-style, and bow to each practice. Conditioning will be given to those who do not comply. Please look presentable at each practice!

During practice times, your opinions do not count. All decisions regarding the team are left to the discretion of the coaches.

Please respect your coach's professional opinions.

Please feel free to speak to your coach about anything. However, keep in mind there is always a time and a place. For example: approaching your coach during team practice, class time, a private lesson or in front of other parents is inappropriate.

Practice times may be altered at any point in the season if necessary.

Extra practices will be scheduled during the season when/if necessary.

Anyone threatening to pull their child from a team may be asked to leave WCA immediately.

Withholding a child from practice should never be used as a form of punishment. Please keep the disciplinary action(s) of your child separate from the sport so it does not affect the team

Homework will never be an acceptable excuse for missing a scheduled World Class event or practice. Please plan accordingly to complete all of your individual responsibilities.

Never post negative comments on social media about World Class Athletics PCB. This includes (but is not limited to):

Facebook, twitter, Instagram, Vine, KIK, text messaging, email etc.

The coaches reserve the right to close practices to the public at any time for any reason.

It is the responsibility of the parent to know what is going on at all times. Please check your email regularly and keep in touch with your Team Mom/Dad.

Parents, relatives, and athletes are never to speak negatively to competition event staff. If you have an issue at a competition or event, WAIT UNTIL WE GET BACK TO THE GYM. Remember you are representing World Class Athletics PCB, owners and staff. Please do NOT try to handle a situation by yourself. It could result in an athlete, spectator, team or program being disqualified.

There will be no arguing or questioning of the coaching decisions at practices or competitions.

If a conflict arises and you feel it needs to be addressed, please contact CJ Green. A meeting will be set up for all parties involved to find a solution that is best for everyone.

Alcohol or substance abuse at a competition or scheduled WCA event will result in immediate expulsion from the team.

NO EXCEPTIONS!

World Class may close practices to parents and friends if "parent issues" become distracting to the teams or coaches.

Please mind your manners so that everyone has a chance to attend their child's practice time.

Choreography camp includes a national championship caliber routine and professional music. Choreography camp is MANDATORY for all World Class athletes. If a member is unable to attend camp, the choreographer will build an open position for them and the Choreography & Music fee will still be charged. Choreography is based on the number of members built into the routine, not just those who are physically present.

New and veteran members joining after camp must also pay the Choreography & Music fee in order to be put into the routine. There is no discount regardless of when your athlete joins the team.

All music, choreography, dances, stunts and pyramids presented to the athletes of World Class Athletics are to remain completely confidential. Routines and ideas should not be discussed, taught or shown to anyone that is not on your 2024-2025 team. NO EXCEPTIONS. Please help us remain a winning program by maintaining confidentiality.

COMMITMENT STATEMENT

2024 - 2025

All-Star cheerleading and dance is a competitive sport which necessitates practice, hard work, sacrifice, teamwork and commitment. I am willing to make the World Class Athletics PCB Program a top priority in my child's life and will do my very best to be as cooperative, supportive, flexible and understanding as possible. We understand the commitment that we are making as a family to the World Class staff, coaches and other team members. We intend to participate for the entire year from May 2024 to May 2025. If for some reason, circumstances occur which require our departure from the program; we do not expect any refund of fees or competition expenses and understand that we may not participate in another All-Star Program within 75 miles until the following season (2025-2026). I understand that fees are due on the 25th of the month. I understand that my provided credit/debit card will be automatically charged on the 25th of each month. If my account is not paid by the 1st of each month, there will be a \$25 late fee charged to my account. I understand that some days of school will be missed in order to attend competitions. I understand that teams practice a minimum of twice per week (excluding novice or prep divisions) during our regular season and possibly an extra day during the week of a scheduled competition. I understand that my child is required to attend all World Class Athletics PCB scheduled performances, competitions and events. I understand that if my child misses practice the week of a scheduled competition, he/she will not be able to compete at that event. I understand that the teams plan to participate in approximately 10-12 performances/competitions per season. I understand that some events require overnight accommodations and travel arrangements (travel/limited travel teams). I understand that a squad member can be dismissed from the team for missing an excessive amount of practices, any violation of the Program Code of Conduct or for any other inappropriate behavior World Class management does not approve of. I understand that consistent negative conversation and gossip will not be tolerated and will result in removal from World Class Athletics PCB. I understand that if my child quits or is asked to leave the program, my child is not allowed to participate in another All-Star program within 75 miles of World Class Athletics PCB. I understand that if my child does participate in another All-Star program within the duration of the 2024-2025 competitive season, World Class Athletics PCB will pursue legal actions. I have familiarized myself with the contents of this handbook. I acknowledge, understand, accept, and agree to comply with the program guidelines provided. I understand this handbook is not intended to cover every situation that could arise during the season. If my account balance is not current, I understand that my child will not be able to participate in practices and/or competitions until my balance is current. I understand that this signed commitment statement/non-compete contract will be maintained and enforced for the entire 2024-2025 season or for the duration of my athlete's participation in the World Class Athletics PCB All-Star Program.
